ORDER AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF FINE IN INSTALLMENTS

Respondents filed a letter on August 15, 1967, wherein they request authority to pay the fine of \$5,190.24 imposed by ordering paragraphs 1 and 2 of Decision No. 72716, dated July 6, 1967, in monthly installments. The letter asserts that payment of the entire fine at one time would create a serious financial problem for respondents.

It appears to the Commission that respondents should be authorized to pay said fine in monthly installments as provided in the order which follows:

IT IS ORDERED that respondents may pay the fine of \$5,190.24 imposed by ordering paragraphs 1 and 2 of Decision No. 72716, dated July 6, 1967, in twelve monthly installments of

\$400.00 each and one final installment of \$390.24 with the first installment due on October 15, 1967 and each succeeding payment due on the fifteenth day of each month thereafter.

In all other respects Decision No. 72716 shall remain in full force and effect.
