ORDER EXTENDING TIME

JAMES E. WALLEY dba AUTO-PHONE TELEPATCH COMPANY, having petitioned on September 11, 1967, for an extension of time in the eighteen-month time limit imposed in Decision No. 70422 on exercising the certificate granted and authority to render service under filed rates and regulations, because of delays caused by various financial and personal reasons he has not been able to file and prosecute before The Federal Communications Commission the necessary application for a construction permit and license, and it appearing to the Commission that an eighteen-month extension should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that ordering Paragraph No. 5 of Decision No. 70422 is hereby changed to read:

"5. The certificate herein granted and the authority to render service under the rates and rules authorized herein will expire if not exercised within thirty-six months after the effective date of this order."

In all other respects, Decision No. 70422 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
