O R D E R

The County of Los Angeles is hereby authorized to construct a pedestrian crossing at separated grades of 243rd Street over the track of the Southern Pacific Company, in Los Angeles County, at the location and substantially as shown by plans (Exhibit B) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6RC-19.3-AD. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Clearances shall be in accordance with General Order No. 26-D, except that during the period of construction, a clearance of not less than 21.50 feet above top of rail is authorized and Southern Pacific Company is authorized to operate with such reduced overhead clearance provided it issues, and files with the Commission, appropriate bulletins to train and enginemen advising them of the temporarily impaired clearance condition and forbidding trainmen to

ride on the tops of cars while operating beneath the structure. Applicant shall notify the Commission and Southern Pacific Company at least 15 days but not more than 30 days in advance of the date when the temporary impaired clearance will be created.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The county desires to complete this project as soon as possible to facilitate the movement of school children. The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
