I N T E R I M O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct, maintain and operate an industrial track at grade across Descanso Avenue in the City of Buena Park, Orange County, at the location described in Application No. 49607, said crossing to be identified as Crossing No. BK-504.2-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the avenue now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one percent. In all other respects the construction shall conform to the specifications set forth in and on Drawing B-4839 (Sheet 2 of 2) attached to, and part of, said Application No. 49607.

Pending further consideration of the protection to be provided in connection with this crossing, the following shall apply:

Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material. No

train, engine, motor or car shall be operated over said crossing in switching operations unless said train, engine, motor or car shall be first brought to a stop and traffic on the highway protected by a member of the train crew or other competent employee of the applicant acting as flagman.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion of construction pursuant to this order, Southern Pacific Company shall so inform the Commission in writing. The authority herein granted shall expire if not exercised within one year from the effective date of this order unless the time be extended by further order of the Commission. The authority shall be subject to revocation or modification if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
