## OPINION

Morris Draying Company operates as a highway common carrier of general commodities, with certain exceptions, in portions of northern and central California. For the purpose of obtaining \$75,000 of working capital, the company seeks authority to execute a Deed of Trust and to issue a note in favor of Oakland Bank of Commerce in the principal amount of \$75,000 repayable in monthly installments of \$852 including interest at the rate of 6-1/2% per annum.

The Commission has considered this matter and finds that: (1) the proposed note is for a proper purpose; (2) the money, property or labor to be procured or paid for by the issue of the note herein authorized is reasonably required for the purpose specified herein; (3) such purpose is not, in whole or in part, reasonably chargeable to operating expenses or to income; and (4) the proposed Deed of Trust will not be adverse to the public interest.

On the basis of the foregoing findings we conclude that the application should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

## ORDER

## IT IS ORDERED that:

A.49671 MON

1. On or after the effective date hereof and on or before December 31, 1967, Morris Draying Company may execute and deliver a Deed of Trust and, for the purpose specified in this proceeding, may issue a note in the principal amount of not exceeding \$75,000, which documents shall be in the same form, or in substantially the same form, as those attached to the application.

2. Morris Draying Company shall file with the Commission a report, or reports, as required by General Order No. 24-B, which order, insofar as applicable, is hereby made a part of this order.

3. This order shall become effective when Morris Draying Company has paid the fee prescribed by Section 1904(b) of the Public Utilities Code, which fee is \$75.
