OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 57879, dated January 20, 1959, required applicant Lake Gregory Water Company to file with the Commission, annually for five years, certain detailed and comprehensive reports on water production and storage. Decision No. 64265, dated September 19, 1962, requires applicant to continue to file the reports annually until further order of the Commission.

Until recent years, applicant depended upon the rather limited water supply available from certain springs or horizontal wells. The most recent reports filed by applicant show that it now may purchase, and has utilized when needed, water from another source.

The Commission finds that further filing of the detailed reports in this proceeding is not necessary and concludes that applicant should be relieved of the present requirement regarding those reports.

IT IS ORDERED that, after the effective date of this order, Lake Gregory Water Company need no longer file in this proceeding the detailed reports required by subparagraph 4.b. of Decision No. 64265.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
