ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

The certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Coast Tank Service Co., a corporation, has been suspended since June 12, 1967, for failure to have on file the required tariffs. To date the carrier has not filed the required tariffs.

Coast Tank Service Co. not having the required tariffs on file, the Commission finds that such failure constitutes good cause for revocation of the certificate.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a petroleum irregular route carrier granted to Coast Tank Service Co., a corporation, by Decision No. 51454 dated May 10, 1955, in Application No. 36498, is hereby revoked.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Coast Tank Service Co., or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Coast Tank Service Co. or after the

above mailing to it, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing or shall have filed proper and lawful tariffs required by Sections 486 and 493 of the Public Utilities Code, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
