ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

The certificate of public convenience and necessity acquired by North Bay Transport, Inc., (North Bay) was suspended on November 26, 1966, for failure to have on file requisite evidence of liability insurance. The certificate was continued in suspension on April 3, 1967, at the request of North Bay, to allow it time to change its equipment and reorganize its business.

An investigation of North Bay's operation reveals that the carrier has never conducted operations as a petroleum irregular route carrier, has not acquired tank trucks or tank trailer equipment and has not sought to reinstate its operating authority as a petroleum irregular route carrier.

North Bay Transport, Inc., having failed to have on file evidence of liability insurance and to commence operations as a petroleum irregular route carrier, the Commission finds that such failures constitute good cause for revocation of the certificate.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a petroleum irregular route carrier acquired by North Bay Transport, Inc., by Decision No. 65983, as amended by Decision No. 68179, dated September 10, 1963, and November 2, 1964, respectively, in Application No. 45630 is hereby revoked.

2. C. R. Nickerson, Agent, is hereby authorized and directed to cancel the participation of North Bay Transport, Inc., from its tariffs on file with the Commission in which North Bay Transport, Inc., is shown as a participating carrier, such cancellation to be made within ninety days after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commissission and to the public.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon North Bay Transport, Inc., or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to C. R. Nickerson, Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon North Bay Transport, Inc., or after the above mailing to it unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
