ORDER SETTING HEARING


The Commission's Transportation Division has prepared and distributed to interested parties a report which recommended that a multiple lot rule be established in Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 7 and 17 to apply in connection with the alternative application provisions of these tariffs. Comments received from several interested parties suggest somewhat different treatment than that proposed by the staff and request that the matter be scheduled for hearing.

The Transportation Division has recommended that a public hearing be scheduled for the purpose of receiving evidence relative to the need for establishing a multiple lot rule to apply in connection with the alternative application provisions of Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 7 and 17.


