ORDER REOPENING PROCEEDING

It appears that an examiner's proposed report was issued herein on February 27, 1967. Exceptions thereto and replies to the exceptions have been filed.

It further appears that, subsequent to the issuance of the proposed report, the Legislature added Section 7538 to the Public Utilities Code.

A number of railroads have requested reopening of this case so that testimony can be offered on the effect of Section 7538 on the issues in this investigation.

The Commission, in the hope of getting the most complete record possible will reopen the proceeding. It does not appear desirable to reopen if the reopening is only for a limited purpose, therefore this case will be reopened generally.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The submission of Case No. 8207 is vacated and set aside.
2. Case No. 8207 is reopened for the receipt of further evidence.
