## BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Application of the State of California  
 Department of Public Works for an order  
 authorizing construction of a crossing  
 at separated grades whereby Interstate  
 Route 5 will be carried over tracks of  
 the Sacramento Northern Railway in Yolo  
 County, referred to as "Yolo Bypass Bridge".)

O R D E R

State of California, Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to construct a crossing at separated grades of Interstate Route 5 over the spur track of Sacramento Northern Railway easterly of Woodland, Yolo County, at the location and substantially as shown by plans (Exhibit B) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 8B-12.0-AC. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Sacramento Northern Railway, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Clearances shall be in accordance with General Order No. 26-D, except that during the period of construction, a clearance of not less than 21'0" above top of rail is authorized and the Sacramento Northern Railway is authorized to operate with such reduced overhead clearance provided it issues, and files with the Commission, appropriate bulletins to train and enginemen advising them of the temporarily impaired clearance condition and forbidding trainmen to ride on the tops of cars while operating beneath the structure.

Applicant shall notify the Commission and the Sacramento Northern Railway at least 15 days but not more than 30 days in advance of the date when the temporary impaired clearance will be created.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
