SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Huddleston Drayage Co., Inc., a corporation, possesses a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a high-way common carrier of general commodities between points within San Francisco Territory.

On August 23, 1967, said carrier filed with this Commission its amended articles of incorporation to indicate that its corporate name has been changed to Rossi Freight Lines, Inc. Accordingly, the certificate will be amended to show the new corporate name and the carrier will be ordered to amend its tariffs on file with the Commission pursuant to General Order No. 80-A. A public hearing is not necessary.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Decision No. 63899 dated July 10, 1962, in Application No. 44561, is hereby amended by substituting "Rossi Freight Lines, Inc." in place and stead of "Huddleston Drayage Co., Inc."

2. Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, Rossi Freight Lines, Inc., shall amend its tariffs on file with this Commission as required by Rule No. 6.4 of General Order No. 80-A.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of certified copies of this order to be made upon Rossi Freight Lines, Inc., and Handler, Baker & Greone, 405 Montgomery Street, San Francisco, CA 94104, or to mail certified copies thereof to them at their last known addresses as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to C. R. Nickerson, Agent.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
