In the Matter of the Joint Application of ZUCKERMAN-MANDEVILLE, INC., doing business as R. C. Zuckerman Telephone Company and THE PACIFIC TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY for an order of the Commission (1) authorizing Zuckerman to discontinue offering telephone service in its authorized service area and to withdraw from the public utility telephone business, (2) authorizing Pacific to expand the boundaries of its Stockton Exchange Area to include said area and to provide telephone service therein, and (3) authorizing Zuckerman to sell and Pacific to purchase certain facilities.

ORDER EXTENDING TIME

The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, having petitioned by letter received on October 25, 1967, for an extension of time to and including December 11, 1967, in the time limit imposed in Decision No. 72944 on refiling a revised map of the Stockton exchange including therein the area now served by Zuckerman-Mandeville, Inc., because of a delay in receiving a certificate from the Federal Communications Commission approving the acquisition of the telephone facilities, application for such certificate having been made on August 25, 1967. It appearing to the Commission that the extension should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Ordering Paragraph No. 2 of Decision No. 72944 is changed to read:

"2. The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company is authorized to expand the boundaries of its Stockton exchange to include the area now served by Zuckerman-Mandeville, Inc., and to provide exchange telephone service therein. The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company shall within 90 days after the effective date of this order refile with this Commission in conformity with the provisions set forth in General Order No. 96-A, a revised map of the Stockton exchange including therein the area now served by Zuckerman-Mandeville, Inc."
