Sierra Telephone Company, Inc., The Siskiyou Telephone Company, Tuolumne Telephone Co., and The Volcano Telephone Company; by the California Independent Telephone Association, in accordance with ordering paragraphs 2 and 5 of Decision No. 73078 in Case No. 8209, is extended until January 15, 1968.
