ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE AUTHORITY

By Decision No. 69367 dated October 26, 1965, in Application No. 47393, Lisle Funeral Home, a California corporation, doing business under the name of Lisle Air Service, was authorized to transport passengers as a passenger air carrier, as defined in Section 2741 of the California Public Utilities Code, between Fresno and Sacramento.

Lisle Funeral Home, by notice to the Commission dated August 25, 1967, advised the Commission, and other parties, of its intention to discontinue said passenger air carrier operation between Fresno and Sacramento on September 29, 1967, as authorized in Section 2763 of the California Public Utilities Code.

A staff review of the notice indicated that the carrier's scheduled passenger air service operations resulted in an estimated loss of \$19,400, with operating ratio of 180.7% for the year ending July 31, 1967. The carrier discontinued its scheduled passenger air service between Fresno and Sacramento, California on September 29, 1967.

It is ordered that the passenger air carrier operative rights created by the Decision No. 69867 in Application No. 47893 are hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Lisle Funeral Home, doing business as Lisle Air Service, are hereby canceled.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
