OPINION AND ORDER

Petitioner, Gerber Products Company, is a manufacturer of canned and preserved baby foods. It seeks amendment of the description of baby foods in Item No. 220 of Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1, to read as follows: "Food, baby, canned or preserved, other than frozen, in hermetically sealed containers, in boxes." $\frac{1}{}$ The proposed description would eliminate the words "consisting only of strained and chopped foods" from the present description.

In support of the proposed change, the petition alleges that the National Classification Board has approved the requested change effective September 27, 1967, in Supplement 13 to National Motor Freight Classification No. A-9 (Item No. 73160). To be consistent with the classification description, the change is requested in Item No. 220 of the Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1.

^{1/} Item No. 220 is headed "Canned or Preserved Foodstuffs (not cold pack or frozen)". The commodity descriptions provided therein apply in connection with Exception Ratings set forth in minimum rate tariffs subject thereto.

Assertedly, the proposed description more aptly describes baby foods now manufactured and shipped in California.

The petition was served on known interested parties, including other manufacturers of canned baby foods, the California Trucking Association and the Canners League of California. It also was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of October 19, 1967. No protests have been received. By letter dated October 23, 1967, the California Trucking Association has informed the Commission that the proposed relief has been considered by that organization and that it has no objection to ex parte consideration. The Canners League of California and California Manufacturers Association also support the granting of the petition without hearing.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the proposed revision is reasonable and that the resulting minimum rates and charges will be just, reasonable and nondiscriminatory rates and charges for the services to which they apply. A public hearing is not necessary. The petition should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 (Appendix A to Decision No. 66195, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective December 23, 1967, First Revised Page 10 and First Revised Page 11, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order,

and may be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.

3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the rates authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rates publiched under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

4. In all other respects said Decision No. 66195, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty-five days after the date hereof.
