EIGHTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 51251 dated March 29, 1955, in Application No. 36660, granted Southern Pacific Company authority to operate freight cars of an overall height of 16°8" from top of rail to top of running board for the sole purpose of transporting automobile bodies from the California-Arizona State Line near Yuma to Los Angeles, thence to Raymer, and Decision No. 51828 dated August 16, 1955, in Application No. 36660, granted similar authority from the State Line near Yuma, Arizona, to Puente via the By-Pass Line to Studebaker, Santa Ana Branch and Firestone Park, and thence San Pedro Branch to the General Motors assembly plant at Southgate.

Southern Pacific Company has advised the Commission that there is no longer any need for these authorities.

IT IS ORDERED that the authority granted by Decision No. 51251 dated March 29, 1955, in Application No. 36660, and by Decision No. 51828 dated August 16, 1955, in Application No. 36660, is hereby cancelled.
