ORDER REVOKING OPERATING AUTHORITY

The Commission ordered respondent in Decision No. 72014 to pay the balance of \$6,124.94 due on the fine imposed on it by ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 71514 in 17 monthly installments of \$350.00 and one final installment of \$174.94 commencing March 1, 1967. Respondent's radial highway common carrier permit was suspended on September 26, 1967 for failure to pay the seventh installment which was due on or before September 1, 1967. It appears that respondent is not financially able to make further payments on said fine. In the circumstances, respondent's operating authority will be revoked, pursuant to Section 3774(c) of the Public Utilities Code, for failure to comply with the Commission's order.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Radial Highway Common Carrier Permit No. 19-55680 issued to Diversified Enterprises, Inc., is hereby revoked and canceled.
2. The directive to pay the balance of \$4,024.94 due on the fine imposed by ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 71514, as amended, is hereby rescinded.
3. The Secretary of the Commission shall cause a copy of the foregoing order to be personally served on respondent through its president, Mrs. Donna Gale.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the completion of such personal service unless, before said effective date, respondent shall have filed a written request for a public hearing on this matter, in which event, the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
