OPINION AND ORDER

ANZA ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC., on August 22, 1967, filed Advice Letter No. 7 submitting, among other sheets, Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 49-E and 50-E setting forth revisions to Schedule No. A., Commercial and Industrial Lighting and Power Service, reducing certain rates and charges therein. On September 19, 1967, the Commission, on its own motion, after receiving a protest, issued an order of investigation and suspended the effective date of said tariff sheets pending an investigation, hearing and decision thereon.

Respondent submitted a letter to the Commission dated October 17, 1967, requesting the Commission to permanently suspend the said tariff sheets.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The suspension of Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 49-E and 50-E filed by Anza Electric Cooperative, Inc. under Advice Letter No. 7, is hereby made permanent.

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2. The investigation in Case No. 8688 is discontinued.
