INTERIM OPINION AND ORDER

Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 names minimum rates and rules for the statewide transportation of general commodities by highway carriers. By this petition California Trucking Association seeks to extend the expiration date governing certain provisions in the above . tariff from December 31, 1967, to June 30, 1968.

According to petitioner, these provisions, which have been established on an experimental basis, have evolved from joint considerations of shippers and carriers and reflect the rate-making judgments of such parties. Petitioner asserts that these provisions were not predicated upon any definite cost or economic evidence and were merely designed to meet immediate problems without the benefit, of any such evidence. The expiration date was provided, petitioner avers, to insure that any detrimental effects upon either carriers or shippers would not be continued indefinitely.

Petitioner states that subsequent experience with these provisions has indicated the need for a possible revision but that anticipated developments concerning Commission staff proposals in l

These provisions pertain to the return transportation of empty pallets and small shipment and volume incentive services and such provisions are set forth in Items Nos. 45, 149, 292, 316, 320, 320-1, 338, 345, 350, 360 and 390 of the tariff.

C. 5432 (Pet. 482) - ams

Order Setting Hearing dated August 31, 1965, in Case No. 5432, have created a climate whereby further consideration of the involved tariff provisions would best be served by deferring action thereon until such time as hearings, which are calendared for early 1968, have been held in the aforementioned proceeding.

Copies of the petition were mailed to various chambers of commerce, shippers organizations and carrier representatives on or about November 15, 1967. The petition was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of November 17, 1967. No objection to the granting of the petition has been received.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that petitioner's proposal is reasonable and the resulting minimum rates and charges will be just, reasonable and nondiscriminatory : minimum rates and charges for the transportation involved. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the petition should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 (Appendix "D" to Decision No. 31606, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein to become effective December 31, 1967, the revised pages attached hereto and listed in Appendix A, also attached hereto, which pages and appendix are made a part hereof.

2. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the fifth day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order. Tariff publications authorized herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order.

3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the tariff provisions authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the tariff provisions published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

4. In all other respects, Decision No. 31606, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty-five days after the date hereof.
