Commodities in Exhibits 3 through 13 were misclassified and should have been rated first class pursuant to Item 71220 of the National Motor Freight Classification A-8 (Cal), with the exception of hydrangeas and poinsettias, which were properly rated third class pursuant to Item 71280 of the National Motor Freight Classification A-8 (Cal)."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that reconsideration of Decision No. 73180, as amended, is denied.
