ORDER OF DISMISSAL

After this complaint was filed, California Water & Telephone Company¹ was authorized by Decision No. 73036 dated September 6, 1967 in Application No. 49123, to establish the Palm Desert Exchange with extended area service to the Palm Springs and Indio Exchanges. The new exchange will include the present Thousand Palms Exchange and is scheduled to become operational on or about January 1, 1969.

Extended area service as authorized is the principal relief sought by the complaint. It appeared that complainant would therefore request dismissal of this complaint. Instead, complainant apprised the Commission by letter dated November 7, 1967 that its primary and continuing concern is the extended area service which is not yet available.

The issue of extended area service has been resolved by Decision No. 73036, supra, and therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the complaint in Case No. 8577 is dismissed without prejudice.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof unless before such effective date complainant shall have filed in this proceeding a written request for hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
