ORDER

The City of Oakland is hereby authorized to construct an industrial track at grade across Hassler Way in the City of Oakland, Alameda County, for the use of Southern Pacific Company in providing railroad service to the Port of Oakland Industrial Park, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. D-12.35-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be

extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
