O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an industrial spur track at grade across First Street in the City of Imperial, County of Imperial at the location as described and in the manner shown in the application.

Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense.

First Street is not improved at the point of construction and this authority shall not be construed as authorizing the opening of said street across the track.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
