Application of Southern Pacific Company for apportionment of maintenance cost of automatic protection at Marsh Creek Road, Crossing No. B-64.6 in Contra Costa County.

By this application Southern Pacific Company requests that the cost of maintaining automatic grade crossing protection at Narsh Creek Road, Crossing No. B-64.6, be apportioned equally between Southern Pacific Company and the County of Contra Costa. The application states that work on installation of the improved automatic protection was commenced on October 21, 2965 , and Comission records indicate it was completed November 19; 1965.

A copy of an indenture entered into by the county and the railroad on June 29, 1965, appears as Exhibit A of the application. It provided that two Standard No. 8 flashing iight grade-crossing signals equipped with automatic gate anms were to be installed by the railroad, replacing two flashing light signals and that the county would reimburse the railroad for fifty percent of the cost of such replacement.

The Commission finds this division of the cost of aiteration of the automatic protection to be reasonable, and the County of Contra Costa has stated by letter that it will be agreeable to tiee same division of the cost of maintenance.

IT IS ORDERED THAT the maintenance cost of automatic grade crossing protection at Crossing No. B-64.6 is hereby divided equally between Southern Pacific Company and the County of Contra $=$ Costa pursuant to Section 1202.2 of the Public Utilities eocie.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
