LV Decision No. 73526 BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for authority to reclassify its non-agency station of Aptos, in the County of Santa Cruz, State of California, from a Class "B" Application No. 49732 non-agency station to a Class "E" (Filed October 13, 1967) non-agency station; to eliminate said station as a point from and to which service is given; to cancel all tariffs to and from said station, and to maintain said station on cimerables and other said station on timetables and other records for operating reasons only. ORDER The verified application of Southern Pacific Company filed on October 13, 1967 discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Apros, in the County of Santa Cruz, during the past two years and that continued maintenance as a Class "B" non-agency station is not necessary. The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of October 17, 1967. Notice of the application has been given to various parties thought to be interested and no protests have been received. A public hearing does not appear to be necessary. It is found that public convenience and necessity no longer require the service in question. Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to reclassify its non-agency station of Aptos, County of Santa Cruz, from a Class "B" non-agency to a Class "E" non-agency station; to eliminate said station as a point from and to which service is given; and to cancel all tariffs applying at said station; and to maintain said station on timetables and other records for operating purposes only on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public. Such tariff changes shall quote this decision number as the requisite authority. This order shall not be construed as authorization to increase rates or charges. - 1 -

Within thirty days after making the changes as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
