## Q R D E R

The verified application of Central California Traction Company filed on October 24, 1967 discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Kenefick during the past ten years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of October 26, 1967. Notice of the application has been given to various parties thought to be interested and no protests have been received. A public hearing does not appear to be necessary.

It is found that public convenience and necessity no longer require the maintenance of such service. Central California Traction Company is hereby authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Kenefick, County of San Joaquin; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public. Such tariff changes shall quote this decision number as the requisite authority. This order shall not be construct as authorization to increase rates or charges. A.49754 CS

Within thirty days after abandonment as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
