IT IS ORDERED that:


1. Ordering Paragraph No. 9 of Decision No. 73068, dated September 12, 1967, in the above-entitled matter, is hereby modified




so as to extend to January 3, 1968, the time within which Citizens Utilities Company of California shall make the filing required by said paragraph.
