1. Decision No. 65451, dated May 28, 1963, as amended by Decision No. 66258, dated November 5, 1963, in Application No. 45264, is further amended by substituting "SXSTEM 99" in place and stead of "Interlines-Blankenship Motor Express."
2. Witinin one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than ten days" notice to the comassion and the public, SYSTEM 99 shall amend its tariffs on file with this Commission as required by Rule No. 6.4 of General Order No. 80-A.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
