SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Interlines-Blankenship Motor Express, a corporation, is a highway common carrier operating under a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by this Commission. On November 27, 1967, it filed its amended articles of incorporation with this Commission which changed its corporate name to SYSTEM 99. Accordingly, its certificate will be amended to show the new corporate name. It will also be ordered to amend its tariffs pursuant to General Order No. 80-A. A public hearing is not necessary.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Decision No. 65451, dated May 28, 1963, as amended by Decision No. 66258, dated November 5, 1963, in Application No. 45264, is further amended by substituting "SYSTEM 99" in place and stead of "Interlines-Blankenship Motor Express-"

2. Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, SYSTEM 99 shall amend its tariffs on file with this Commission as required by Rule No. 6.4 of General Order No. 80-A.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
