SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER GRANTING MODIFICATION

Applicant has requested an order of the Commission granting temporary authority to construct Imperial Highway at grade, Crossing No. 36-120.4, across the tracks of the San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway Company's Main Line in Imperial County as authorized in Decision 72557 dated June 6, 1967 in Application No. 49208 but without the automatic protection required in said decision. Applicant requests the temporary authority for a period of 8 months to detour traffic on State Route 98 during required alteration work of Coyote Wells Underpass, Crossing No. 36-119.1-B.

The railway is unable to obtain materials for the installation of the automatic protection as authorized in Decision No. 72557 for an estimated period of 6 months.

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the State of California Department of Public Works is authorized to construct Imperial Highway Crossing No. 36-120.4 as authorized in Decision No. 72557 with crossing protection consisting of two Standard No. 1

Crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material. This authorization shall expire eight months after the date of this order or upon the reopening of Coyote Wells Underpass, Crossing No. 36-119.1-B, if such reopening should take place before the expiration of the eight months.

In all other respects Decision No. 72557 shall remain in full force and effect.
