OPINION AND ORDER

Yreka Western Railroad Company, a corporation, operates as a highway common carrier of general commodities between Montague, Yreka and Etna and intermediate points, and between Yreka and Orleans and intermediate points. By Decision No. 71830, dated January 17, 1967, in Case No. 5432 (Petition for Modification No. 439), it was authorized to publish minimum per-shipment charges lower than those otherwise applicable. The authorized charges are published to expire with February 5, 1968. By this petition, it seeks authority to continue the current authority for a further one-year period.

Petitioner has heretofore shown that the conditions surrounding the transportation involved are not generally applicable to other regions of the State; that petitioner has always been subject to severe proprietary competition for the traffic involved; that minimum charges higher than those proposed would divert

MINIMUM CHARGES IN CENTS PER SHIPMENT BETWEEN YREKA AND ORLEANS AND INTERMEDIATE POINTS

Weight of shipment less 14 pounds, minimum charge 125 cents.

Weight of shipment 14 pounds and over:

- (1) If classified 1st class or lower, for 100 pounds at the class or commodity rate applicable thereto; or
- (2) If classified higher than 1st class, for 100 pounds at the 1st class rate; or
- (3) If shipment contains different articles, and no article is rated higher than 1st class, for 100 pounds at the class or commodity rate applicable to the articles taking highest rate; or if any of the articles is rated higher than 1st class, for 100 pounds at the 1st class rate; but
- (4) In no event shall the minimum charge be less than 185 cents.
