SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 73586, entered today in Case No. 5440

(Petition for Modification No. 45) ordered that further public hearing be scheduled for the receipt of evidence in that proceeding and final disposition thereof. Pending final disposition of the aforementioned matter, the decision also provided that Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 be amended by separate order establishing therein commodity rates for the transportation of pozzolana on an interim basis.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 (Appendix "D" of Decision No. 31606, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective March 1, 1968, Fortieth Revised Page 8 and Original Page 51-HH, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.


2. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order and may be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.

3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the rates authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rates published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing the long- and short-haul departures and to this order.


4. In all other respects, Decision No. 31606, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.


This order shall become effective twenty-five days after the date hereof.


