ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Applicant has requested an extension of time within which to exercise the authority granted in Decision No. 72529, alleging that the project has not been completed due to the difficulty in obtaining signal material but that it is anticipated that the project will be completed by May 31, 1968.

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the time limit within which applicant may exercise the authority granted in said decision with interim crossing protection specified therein pending installation of automatic protection, is hereby extended to May 31, 1968.

In all other respects, Decision No. 72529 shall remain in full force and effect.
