<u>O P I N I O N</u>

By this petition Devine & Son Trucking Co., a corporation, operating as a highway common carrier of lumber, requests authority to publish a rate of 6-3/4 cents per 100 pounds, subject to a minimum weight of 44,000 pounds per unit of carrier's equipment for the transportation of lumber from Paskenta to Corning, both in Tehama County. The applicable minimum rate, named in the Commission's Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2, is 12-1/2 cents per 100 pounds, minimum weight 44,000 pounds.

By Decision No. 71989, dated February 7, 1967, in Application No. 48918, petitioner herein was authorized to publish a rate of 6-1/2 cents per 100 pounds, minimum weight 44,000 pounds per unit of carrier's equipment, for the transportation of lumber (milled, surfaced or finished) from and to the above mentioned points. That authorization is subject to expire on February 5, 1968.

Petitioner is now transporting shipments of lumber under the rate of 6-1/2 cents for Crane Mills and is desirous of continuing this service at the proposed rate of 6-3/4 cents. According to the

petition, said shipper also operates motor trucks and has indicated that it will be required further to expand its private carriage operation if the relief herein sought is not granted.

According to an exhibit attached to the petition the operation here in issue is conducted, at current expense levels, at a cost of 5.96 cents per 100 pounds, before provision for income taxes. This would reflect an operating ratio of 88.3 percent under the sought rate.

The petition was shown on the Commission's daily calendar for December 19, 1967. No protests have been received.

It appears, and the Commission finds, that the proposed rate is reasonable and justified by transportation conditions. A public hearing is not necessary. We conclude that the sought authority should be granted. Because the conditions under which the service is performed may change at any time, the authority will be made to expire at the end of one year, unless extended, modified or cancelled by order of the Commission.

<u>ORDER</u>

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Devine & Son Trucking Co., a corporation, operating as a highway common carrier, is hereby authorized to publish and file, to expire with February 5, 1969, a rate of 6-3/4 cents per 100 pounds, minimum weight 44,000 pounds per unit of carrier's equipment used, for the transportation of lumber (milled, surfaced or finished) from Paskenta to Corning.
