SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 72418 as amended by Decision No. 73126, dated May 16 and September 26, 1967, respectively, in Case No. 5432 (Order Setting Hearing dated October 13, 1965) et al., the Commission established minimum rates effective October 28, 1967, for the transportation of trailer coaches and campers.

The Commission notified all common carriers of general commodities of the foregoing fact by letter stating that the required tariff filings should be made in the event that such common carriers hold themselves out to perform the above service.

Security Transportation Co., a corporation, has informed the Commission by letter that it does not desire to hold itself

out to perform the aforementioned service and requests that its certificate be amended to exclude the transportation of trailer coaches and campers.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that amendment of the carrier's certificate, as requested, would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission concludes that the carrier's request should be granted.


IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Appendix A of Decision No. 60147, as heretofore amended, is further amended by incorporating therein Second Revised Page 1, attached hereto, in revision of First Revised Page 1.


2. Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, Security Transportation Co. shall amend its tariffs on file with the Commission to reflect the authority granted herein.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.







I. Security Transportation Co., a corporation, by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in the decision noted in the margin is authorized to transport general commodities between the points and over the routes hereinafter set forth; provided, however, that applicant shall not transport any shipments of the following commodities:

1. Used household goods and personal effects not packed in accordance with the crated property requirements set forth in Item No. 5 of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-B.

2. Automobiles, trucks and buses, viz.: new and used, finished or unfinished passenger automobiles (including jeeps), ambulances, hearses and taxis; freight automobiles, automobile chassis, trucks, truck chassis, truck trailers, trucks and trailers combined, buses and bus chassis.

3. Livestock, viz.: bucks, bulls, calves, cattle, cows, dairy cattle, ewes, goats, hogs, horses, kids, lambs, oxen, pigs, sheep, sheep camp outfits, sows, steers, stags or swine.

4. Commodities requiring protection from heat by the use of ice (either water or solidified carbon dioxide), by mechanical refrigeration, or by release of liquefied gases.

5. Liquids, compressed gases, commodities in semiplastic form and commodities in suspension in liquids in bulk, in tank trucks, tank trailers, tank semitrailers, or a combination of such highway vehicles.

6. Commodities when transported in bulk in dump trucks or in hopper-type trucks.

7. Commodities when transported in motor vehicles equipped for mechanical mixing in transit.

8. Fresh or green fruits, fresh or green vegetables, or mushrooms when the point of destination of the shipment is a cannery, accumulation station, cold storage plant, pre-cooling plant, or winery.

9. Trailer coaches and campers, including integral parts and contents when the contents are within the trailer coach or camper.
