OPINION AND ORDER

Distance Table 6 contains the basis for determining constructive mileages in connection with various minimum rate tariffs issued by the Commission. It has come to the Commission's attention that service was inaugurated on October 28, 1967, at the new Sacramento County Metropolitan Airport. This facility occupies part of the area covered by a segment of the Elkhorn Road between Junctions Numbers 2568 and 2569 as shown on Map 2 of Distance Table 6 and said location required the closing of the aforementioned segment of road and the use of other access roads to the airport, which are not shown on the aforementioned map of the distance table.

The Commission staff investigated this matter and set forth the results of such investigation in a document entitled "Report on the Constructive Mileages to Sacramento Metropolitan Airport. (Sacramento County) for Distance Table 6." That document is hereby received in evidence as Ex Parte Exhibit No. 11.

In the circumstances it appears and the Commission finds that (1) the constructive mileages set forth in the supplement attached hereto, when applied in conjunction with the minimum rate tariffs subject thereto, will result in just, reasonable and non-discriminatory minimum rates for transportation governed by said tariffs; and (2) the provisions of the distance table as hereinafter modified are and will be, reasonable provisions for the transportation of property by common carriers as defined in the Public Utilities Code. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that Distance Table 6 should be amended as provided in the order which follows. Other minor changes not related to the subject matter will be made in some of the tariff pages herein being revised.¹

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Distance Table 6 (Decision No. 72081, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective March 30, 1968, the supplement and revised pages attached hereto and listed in Appendix A also attached hereto, which supplement, pages and appendix are made a part hereof.

2. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order

on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public and such tariff publications shall be made effective not later than March 30, 1968; and tariff publications which are authorized but not required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the tariff pages incorporated in this order. Tariff publications required and authorized herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order.

3. Common carriers are authorized to adopt Supplement 2 and the proposed tariff pages herein to Distance Table 6, as a basis for computing distances for use in applying distance rates in their common carrier tariffs for the transportation of:

- (a) commodities for which minimum rates have not been established, or
- (b) commodities which are subject to higher rates than, or more restrictive provisions than, the minimum rates or provisions otherwise applicable.


4. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining rates based on the mileages and other provisions authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified

only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rates published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.




5. In all other respects Decision No. 72081, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
