ORDER EXTENDING TIME

The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has petitioned, by letter on December 22, 1967, for an extension until June 1, 1968, to conduct further studies related to ordering paragraph 4., of Decision No. 72130, and to delay until the October 1969 directory issue any rearrangements of the Gardena telephone directory. The delay is necessary to undertake further studies in the areas of Torrance, Lomita and San Pedro for the purpose of validating the soundness of the proposed changes. Good cause appearing therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that ordering paragraph No. 4 of Decision No. 72130 is hereby changed to read:

"4. The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company shall conduct a study of the possibility and desirability of moving the Gardena classified listings from the Compton classified section to the Torrance-Lomita-San Pedro classified section in the October 1969 directory. The results of this study, including recommendations, shall be filed with the Commission not later than June 1, 1968."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said Decision No. 72130 shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this order.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
