ORDER SETTING HEARING

By Application No. 49758, filed October 27, 1967, Pacific Southcoast Freight Bureau, on behalf of carriers participating in its tariffs, seeks authority to increase the switching rates and charges of such carriers applicable to California intrastate transportation subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.






Various minimum rate tariffs published by the Commission contain provisions for the alternative application of common carrier rates which may be applied in lieu of the minimum rates when such common carrier rates produce a lower aggregate charge for the same transportation than results from the application of the minimum rates. Accordingly, hearings in the several minimum rate investigation cases should be held with the hearings in Application No. 49758 for the purpose of determining whether common carriers

maintaining, under outstanding authorizations permitting the alternative use of rail rates, rates below the specific minimum rate levels otherwise applicable, should be authorized and directed to increase such rates to the level of the rail rates established pursuant to decision in said Application No. 49758, or to the level of the specific minimum rates, whichever is lower, and to cancel such rates in the event competitive rail rates are no longer published in rail tariffs.

IT IS ORDERED that hearings in these proceedings be held concurrently with hearings in Application No. 49758 before Examiner Bishop on March 28, 1968, at 10:00 a.m. in the Commission's Courtroom, San Francisco.
