ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The staff's review of applicant's request for an increase in passenger fares (Redman - Passenger Tariff No. 1, Cal. P.U.C. No. 1) between Bakersfield and Kern County Airport, disclosed that exhibits attached to the application were insufficient to substantiate the proposed increases and that additional operating rights were required for the service outlined in the application.

Applicant's attorney was advised of the deficiencies in the pleading by staff letters of May 9 and 16, 1967 and by telephone on May 11 and 13, 1967. On September 15, 1967 the staff, by letter, requested applicant's attorney to advise promptly whether applicant intended to proceed, or to dismiss the application. A copy of that letter is hereby included in this record as Exhibit 1. To date, there has been no amendment or supplemental data filed.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the application of Linas T. Redman, filed herein on February 10, 1967, be and it is hereby dismissed for lack of prosecution.

Applicant is placed on notice that he is authorized to operate only over the routes named in his certificate of public convenience and necessity and to charge the fares set forth in his tariff on file with this Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
