TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

It being alleged in the complaint that defendant Gardner is a public utility; that he has agreed and is about to sell certain wells presently used in supplying water to the public utility customers of defendant Slack; and the complainant praying that the Commission restrain the sale of said wells, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that defendant George Gardner, his agents, servants, and employees be and they are hereby restrained from selling, transferring or otherwise disposing of certain wells owned by defendant Gardner located in or near the city of Calimesa, California, and used for the purpose of serving water to defendant Harry V. Slack and his public utility water customers, pending the further order of the Commission.

Said defendants having been granted a period of time to and including March 5, 1968 within which to answer the complaint.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said proceeding be set for hearing before Commissioner Gatov or Examiner Gregory on the 7th day of March, 1968 at 10:00 a.m. at Garden Air Golf Association, 1300 Third Street, in the City of Calimesa, California.

The Secretary is directed to cause a certified copy of the foregoing order to be served upon the complainant, upon each of the defendants named in the complaint, upon Security First National Bank of Calimesa, California, upon Henry N. Wochholz, President, Calimesa Water District, P. O. Box 394, Calimesa, California, and upon Charles A. Prince, 1800 Avenue of the Stars, Los Angeles, California, 90067.
