O P I N I O N

Applicant had a public utility warehouse operating right stated for it in Case No. 6533; several locations with their various square footages were named, including 6,330 square feet at Mountain View. The application alleges that for sometime past it has had only one storer at Mountain View. This storer now wants to move his storage to another facility of applicant at San Jose. Applicant's attorney has indicated that the storer will not completely vacate the premises in Mountain View until April 1, 1968. Applicant is willing to transport the remaining merchandise at no expense to storer to its San Jose warehouse after that date.

The application further alleges that no requests for storage space at Mountain View from other storers have been received for a considerable period of time. Applicant now requests authority to abandon its operation in Mountain View. The request appears reasonable under the circumstances and it will be granted.

The Commission finds that public convenience and necessity no longer require that Union Ice & Storage Company operate public utility warehouse space in Mountain View.

The Commission concludes that the application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Union Ice & Storage Company is authorized to discontinue public utility warehouse operations at Mountain View subject to the following conditions:

- a. Applicant shall continue as a public utility warehouseman at Mountain View, rendering all services specified in its tariffs, at rates and charges therein provided until April 1, 1968, and on and after the effective date hereof, applicant shall not be required to receive any additional goods for storage.
- b. Applicant shall, within twenty days after the effective date of this order, file with the Commission its written acceptance of this order, including all of the provisions and conditions thereof.
- c. Applicant shall cause to be prepared and to be mailed or otherwise delivered to each of its storage patrons, on or before twenty days after the effective date of this order, a true and complete copy of this order.
- d. Applicant shall, at the direction of the owner of any property remaining in storage on April 1, 1968, transport such property to any available public warehouse at the expense of applicant and at no expense or risk to the owner of the property transported.
- e. Applicant shall (1) file with the Commission within thirty days after discontinuance of operations a verified statement that it has fully complied with conditions a to d, inclusive; and (2) cancel all tariffs of applicant as a public utility warehouseman at Mountain View, which it has on file with the Commission, such cancellation to be made effective April 1, 1968, on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

2. Effective concurrently with the effective date of tariff filings authorized in paragraph 1.e hereof, the operative authority

of applicant as a public utility warehouseman at Mountain View is
revoked and Appendix A to Decision No. 68166 in Application
No. 46936 is amended by incorporating therein First Revised Page 1,
attached hereto, in revision of Original Page 1.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days
after the date hereof.
