## BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Investigation on the Commission's own motion into the operations, rates and practices of ROBERT S. KAHN, an individual, doing business as ROBERT'S VAN & STORAGE, ROBERT'S VAN LINES OF CALIFORNIA, ROSSMOOR VAN & STORAGE and ROBERT S. KAHN and ALBERT NEWBERG, copartners, doing business as ALLSTATE MOVING & STORAGE OF CALIFORNIA, BOY'S TRANSFER & STORAGE and MARINA MOVING & STORAGE.

ORDER AMENDING DECISION NO. 73402

Respondent Kahn filed a letter on February 26, 1968, wherein he requests authority to pay the fine of \$750 imposed on him by ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 73402, dated November 28, 1967, in monthly installments of approximately \$40 per month. Paragraph 1 authorized him to pay the fine in monthly installments of \$125 each. The letter asserts that respondent Kahn has ceased his household goods carrier operation; that his present income is very low; and that if his request is granted, respondent partners (Kahn and Newberg) will pay the fine of \$150 imposed on them by ordering paragraph 2 of said decision in a single payment rather than in installments as authorized by said paragraph.

It appears to the Commission that respondent Kahn should be authorized to pay the \$750 fine imposed on him in monthly installments as provided in the order which follows and that respondent partners should be directed to pay the \$150 fine imposed on them in a single payment.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Respondent Kahn may pay the fine of \$750 imposed on him by ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 73402, dated November 28, 1967, in Case No. 8623, in fifteen monthly installments of \$50 each, with the first installment due May 1, 1968 and each succeeding payment due on the first day of each month thereafter.

2. Respondent partners shall pay the fine of \$150 imposed on them by ordering paragraph 2 of said Decision No. 73402 in a single payment of \$150 due on April 15, 1968.

3. In all other respects, said Decision No. 73402 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
