OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 73472, dated December 12, 1967, Skymark Airlines, Inc., was authorized to operate as a passenger air carrier between various points within the State. Appendix A of said decision required applicant to provide as a minimum service the number of flights proposed in the application. The number of flights proposed varied as to points and as to weekdays and weekends. It is requested that it be authorized to reduce the minimum number of flights Monday through Friday between Sacramento and Oakland from 4 to 2 and between Sacramento, San Jose and Monterey from 3 to 2.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Skymark Airlines, Inc. is authorized to reduce the minimum number of flights operated Monday through Friday between Sacramento and Oakland from 4 to 2 and between Sacramento, San Jose and Monterey from 3 to 2.

2. After the effective date hereof and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public applicant shall amend its timetables presently on file with this Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
