## SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 70721, dated May 17, 1966, in this proceeding, William F. Wise was ordered to collect undercharges from five shippers. Wise subsequently was adjudged bankrupt. Either Wise or his trustee has collected from four of the shippers. An action has been brought against the fifth and trial has been set for August 30, 1968, in Los Angeles.

Paragraph 3 of the order in Decision No. 70721 directs Wise to make monthly progress reports. Under the circumstances outlined above these will provide no information useful to the Commission until after the court trial. Furthermore, monthly reports are no longer necessary now that four out of five accounts have been collected.

Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. William F. Wise or Jack A. Ulrich, his trustee in bankruptcy, are relieved of the requirement of filing monthly reports imposed by ordering paragraph 3 of Decision No. 70721 issued on May 17, 1966 herein. In lieu of such reports Wise or said trustee shall file a report on or before October 7, 1968, C. 8337 ds

and on the first Monday of each calendar quarter year thereafter until such undercharges have been collected in full or until further order of this Commission.

2. As herein modified Decision No. 70721 is continued in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
