SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 70757 dated May 24, 1966, in this proceeding, the Commission established commodity descriptions for canned or preserved foodstuffs in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5 including¹ canned meats, which are not prepared for human consumption.

It has been brought to the Commission's attention that the descriptions for canned or preserved foodstuffs, which originally governed the rates named in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5, included canned meats prepared for human consumption² and that the commodity in question was apparently excluded from such commodity descriptions through inadvertence.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds that canned meats prepared for human consumption should be included in the aforementioned commodity descriptions. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5 should be amended accordingly.

² Item 210-K of Supplement 88 to Pacific Southcoast Freight Bureau, Agent, Exception Sheet 1-S contained the involved commodity description prior to the date such description was transferred to the Commission's Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5 (Appendix A of Decision No. 32504, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective May 4, 1968, First Revised Page 22-D, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.


2. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order, and may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff page incorporated in this order.

3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the commodity description authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the commodity description published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.


4. In all other respects, Decision No. 32504, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.


This order shall become effective twenty-four days after the date hereof.


