
## ORDER RESCINDING ORDER OF REVOCATION

Decision No. 71833 dated January 17, 1967, in this proceeding, provided for the revocation of the certificate of public convenience and necessity of Mainline Transportation System, a corporation (Mainline) for failure, on the part of the carrier, to have on file with the Commission the required tariffs and evidence of liability insurance. That decision also provided that the effective date of the order would be stayed in the event that Mainline filed with the Commission before such effective date a written request for public hearing.

On February 14, 1967, Mainline filed a written request for public hearing thereby staying the effective date of the order and subsequently filed evidence of liability insurance and the required tariffs but permitted its participation in National Motor Freight Classifications A-9 and A-9(CAL) to be canceled thereby postponing

rescission of the aforementioned order of revocation. Mainline's certificate was suspended for this latter failure and reinstated when the required classifications were filed with the Commission.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the record in this proceeding concerning the status of the carrier's operative right should be clarified. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that Decision No. 71833, supra, should be rescinded.

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 71833 dated January 17, 1967, in Application No. 42764 is hereby rescinded.
