OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., seeks authority, on behalf of Theresa Gotelli, Adolph Gotelli and Edward Gotelli, doing business as N. A. Gotelli Trucking (Gotelli), and Imperial Truck Lines, Inc. (Imperial) to cancel joint rates currently in effect between these two carriers from one of its tariffs.¹

Applicant alleges that the records of Gotelli and Imperial indicate that they have not interchanged any traffic under the rates in question for more than two years. Applicant avers that there is no indication that this situation will change in the future and that the general public will suffer no loss with the proposed cancellation of rates since such rates are maintained in Tariff No. 111 for application via other carriers.

Applicant states that increases resulting from the proposal herein would not increase the California intrastate gross revenue of either of the carriers involved by as much as one percent.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of February 14, 1968. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that increases resulting from cancellation of joint rates as proposed in the application are justified. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the application should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., is hereby authorized, on behalf of Theresa Gotelli, Adolph Gotelli and Edward Gotelli, doing business as N. A. Gotelli Trucking, and Imperial Truck Lines, Inc., to cancel joint rates from its Local, Joint and Proportional Freight and Express Tariff No. 111, Cal.P.U.C. No. 15, as proposed in the application.

2. Tariff publications authorized to be made as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than thirty days after the effective date of this order on not less than thirty days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

3. The authority herein granted shall expire unless exercised within ninety days after the effective date of this order.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
