O R D E R

State of California Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to construct a crossing at separated grades of State Route 395 over the main line track of The Western Pacific Railroad Company, near Doyle, Lassen County, at the location and substantially as shown by plans (Exhibit B) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 4-361.7-A.

Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by The Western Pacific Railroad Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Clearances shall be in accordance with General Order No. 26-D, except that during the period of construction, clearances of not less than 21'0" above top of rail are authorized and The Western Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to operate with such reduced overhead clearances provided it issues and files with the Commission, appropriate

bulletins to train and engine crews advising them of the temporarily impaired clearance conditions and forbidding trainmen to ride on top of cars while operating beneath the structures.

Applicant shall notify the Commission and The Western Pacific Railroad Company at least 15 days, but not more than 30 days in advance of the date when the temporarily impaired clearances will be created.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
