OPINION

Southern Counties Gas Company of California, in this proceeding, requests a certificate of public convenience and necessity to exercise the rights and privileges of a franchise granted by the City of Yorba Linda, permitting the installation, maintenance and use of a gas distribution system upon the streets of said city.

The franchise referred to, a copy of which is attached to the application and designated as Exhibit "A", was granted by the city in accordance with the Franchise Act of 1937 and is of indeterminate duration. A fee is payable annually to the city equivalent to 2 percent of the gross receipts arising from the use, operation, or possession of the franchise, but not less than 1 percent of the gross annual receipts from sales of gas within the limits of the city under said franchise.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that a certificate of public convenience and necessity is granted to Southern Counties Gas Company of California to exercise the rights and privileges granted by the City of Yorba Linda, by Ordinance No. 22, adopted on January 15, 1968.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days efter the date hereof.
